

GIRLS GOLF

Revised: **June 2018**

1.0 DATE

The date shall be set in the WOSSAA calendar, sometime in the fall.

2.0 LOCATION

The tournament shall be rotated as per the rotating list of conveners (see Appendix 3).

3.0 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE AND PROCEDURES

3.1 A one day 18 hole tournament is to be held.

3.2 Each team will consist of four players.

3.3 A student athlete who has competed in a provincial or national tournament within the past 12 months outside of the high school program, shall be classified as an Open participant within the individual division.

4.0 ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES

4.1 Entries are to be made by the Conference convener. It is the responsibility of Conference Convener to communicate the WOSSAA representatives to the WOSSAA Convener after the Conference Championship, no later than the next school day.

4.2 Entry fees are to be established by the Convener, to cover known fixed costs of the tournament.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be eligible according to ByLaw 2 of the WOSSAA Constitution.

6.0 RULES AND OFFICIALS

6.1 The rules of competition shall be those contained in the WOSSAA Constitution.

6.2 The rules of golf according to the GAO will be followed as well as any local rules of the hosting club.

7.0 SCORING

7.1 The team championship shall be determined by the aggregate scores of the three team members.

7.2 In the event of a tie, it shall be resolved by all team members playing a one hole play-off with the winners determined by the lowest aggregate score. If a second play-off is necessary, it shall be played as above.

8.0 UNIFORM

The dress code of the hosting golf course shall be in effect.

9.0 AWARDS

9.1 A WOSSAA team plaque will be awarded to the first place team.

9.2 Individual medals shall be awarded to first, second and third place team members as well as the coach each team.

9.3 Medals shall be awarded to the first, second and third place individual golfers.

10.0 OFSAA ENTRY

According to current OFSAA Playing Regulations.
