## WOSSAA “AA” Boys and Girls Championship 2017

Congratulations to you and your team for advancing to the 2017 WOSSAA “AA” Soccer Championships. Both boys and girls “AA” matches will be held on Thursday, May 25, 2017 in Tillsonburg. Listed below are a few logistical items to make the day progress smoothly.

### 1. WOSSA will be located at Tillsonburg Minor Soccer Park.

### 3. Entry Fee / WOSSAA Eligibility Sheet

The entry fee for all teams will be \$280. This money will be used to pay for the field rentals, referees, the WOSSAA medals and plaques. Please make all cheques payable to “**Parkside Collegiate Institute**”. Also, bring a copy of your approved WOSSAA Eligibility Sheet. These items will be collected when we meet on the day of competition.

### 4. Match Times

The tournament draw is attached. There will be **two** games played at one time. In order to keep on schedule, please ensure that when your team enters the pitch for the ensuing match, the team is ready to play. There will not be time for lengthy pre-game warm ups once you are on the game field. Game times have been set so that teams have a one game rest period before their next match.

The team on the left side of the draw, for your first game, will be deemed the home team. This team will provide the game ball, game sheet and have choice of jersey color. For your second game, a coin toss will be used to determine the home team. All teams are asked to bring a set of pinnies in case two teams have the same color of jersey.

At the Clubhouse, tracking of all the scores from the day’s action will be posted on a large whiteboard.

### 5. Playing Regulations (PR)

These can be found at <http://www.wossaa.on.ca/>. Please read if you are not familiar with these rules as they may be slightly different from your regular season (for example, WOSSAA allows a maximum of 22 players to dress- **20 players plus 2 identified goal keepers**). Substitutions will be allowed on your own throw-ins and the other team can make substitutions at the same time. **Games are 2 x 35 minute halves.**

Please note that if any game is tied at the end of regulation time, two full ten minute overtime periods will be held (no golden goal) and then a penalty shootout if the score is still tied after this extra twenty minutes.

## 6. Eligibility

A quick reminder: Each of your athletes must have played in one regular season league game in order to be eligible to play at WOSSAA

## 7. Game Sheets

The home team will use the game sheets that it used during league play. The home team will be responsible for completing the home side of the game sheet and this sheet needs to be given to the opposition before the game starts. Then, the opposing team's coach will give the referee the completed game sheet.

## 8. Cleanliness

Please ensure when your team leaves the playing field that all refuse is placed in the strategically-located barrels around the fields. It becomes rather awkward for a coach and the team to approach a sideline when the previous team has left its refuse on the grass.

## 9. Awards Presentation

After the medal games, coaches, players and spectators are to remain at the field of play for the presentation of the WOSSAA medals and plaques.

## 10. Advancement to OFSAA

Girls "AA" level, the WOSSAA winner will advance to the OFSAA Championships which will be held in North Bay from June 1-3, 2017

Boys "AA" level, the WOSSAA winner will advance to the OFSAA Championships which will also be held in North Bay from June 1-3, 2017.

Please ensure you check the websites for your appropriate OFSAA competition as there is some paperwork that can be filled out ahead of time if you feel your team has the opportunity for advancement. **The deadline for entries for all OFSAA levels is Saturday May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 11:59 pm.** You and your school are responsible for registering for OFSAA and paying your OFSAA fees.
