8:00 AM - Coaches meeting
8:30 AM - Competition begins
- ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 per player (\$30.00 for doubles or mixed)
- COACHES Please give your player fees to your Conference Convenor
- CONFERENCE CONVENORS Please collect ALL player fees from your respective coaches AND write a cheque payable to **Oakridge Secondary School** for your entire conference.
ONLY 1 (one) cheque for player fees PER conference (\$480)
- ELIGIBILITY: 1) Players' eligibility forms must be sent to the convenor or brought to the tournament.
2) Each player must be eligible under the WOSSAA Constitution.
3) Each player must have competed in this year's conference championship.
4) Each player who qualifies for an event at the conference championship may compete **ONLY** in the same event at WOSSAA.
5) No player may enter more than one event.
6) If eligible players are unable to compete at WOSSAA, the next highest conference finishers may be substituted. All such substitutes must be authorized by the conference convenor prior to WOSSAA competition and communicated to the WOSSAA convenor via the conference convenor.
7) All entries per event per school shall count toward that school's point total for the team title.
- SHUTTLE: Yonex Mavis 350 Cork Base (Yellow)
- UNIFORM: T - Shirt - predominately white OR "team / school" colours. Doubles teams must coordinate.
Shorts - 1 solid colour
- RULES: 1) Badminton Canada rules apply ie. "rally point" scoring system is used.
2) All matches "best of 3" to 21 points (regulation "setting" rules apply).
3) ALL players MUST wear CSA approved (ASTM F803) protective eyewear.
4) Coaching - 1 coach only
- between 1st + 2nd game = 30 sec; on court
- between 2nd + 3rd game = 2 mins; player may leave court but must leave racquet

AWARDS: 1) Individual medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers.
2) WOSSAA team championship plaque to the school accumulating to the highest point total. ALL "placings" count towards team point total.
1st - 10 pts
2nd - 7 pts
3rd - 5 pts
4th - 3 pts
5th - 1 pt (2 entries tied)

MISC: WOSSAA t-shirts will be sold at \$15.00 each.

OFSSA: May 4th - 6th 2017 in Pain Court
Top 2 finishers per event qualify.
Coaches & players will need to confirm before leaving tournament.
ALL participants and/or their schools are responsible for OFSAA fees.
Fee information will be available at WOSSAA.
