

POLICY 3

WOSSAA CONCUSSION CODE OF CONDUCT (RE: ROWAN'S LAW)

Revised: June 2023

In accordance with Rowan's Law, participants (student-athletes, parents/guardians, coaches and team managers) at WOSSAA Championships are expected to adhere to their Board's established policy and procedures with respect to concussions.

Participants at all WOSSAA Championships (with the exception of cross country, golf, badminton and tennis) will be required to provide proof, in writing, of completion of their Board's Concussion Awareness resource as well as having reviewed their Board's Concussion Code of Conduct within the last 12 months.
