- ELIGIBILITY:**
- 1) Players' eligibility forms must be sent to the Convener or brought to the tournament.
 - 2) Each player must be eligible under the WOSSAA Constitution.
 - 3) Each player must have competed in this year's conference championship.
 - 4) Each player who qualifies for an event at the conference championship may compete ONLY in the same event at WOSSAA.
 - 5) No player may enter more than one event.
 - 6) If eligible players are unable to compete at WOSSAA, the next highest conference finishers may be substituted. All such substitutes must be authorized by the conference Convener prior to WOSSAA competition and communicated to the WOSSAA Convener via the conference Convener.
 - 7) All entries per event per school shall count toward that school's point total for the team title.

- RULES:**
- 1) Badminton Canada rules apply ie. "rally point" scoring system is used.
 - 2) All matches "best of 3" to 21 points (regulation "setting" rules apply).
 - 3) ALL players MUST wear CSA approved (ASTM F803) protective eyewear.
 - 4) **Coaching:** Only Coaches which have been an active member of your coaching staff throughout the season are allowed to coach during the WOSSAA Championship
- 1 coach only

- between 1st + 2nd game = 30 sec; on court
- between 2nd + 3rd game = 2 mins; player may leave court but must leave racquet

AWARDS:

- 1) Individual medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers.
- 2) WOSSAA team championship plaque to the school accumulating to the highest point total. ALL "placings" count towards team point total.
 - 1st - 10 pts
 - 2nd - 7 pts
 - 3rd - 5 pts
 - 4th - 3 pts
 - 5th - 1 pt (2 entries tied)

 Top 2 finishers per event qualify.
 Coaches & players will need to confirm before leaving tournament.
