Definition of Ranked

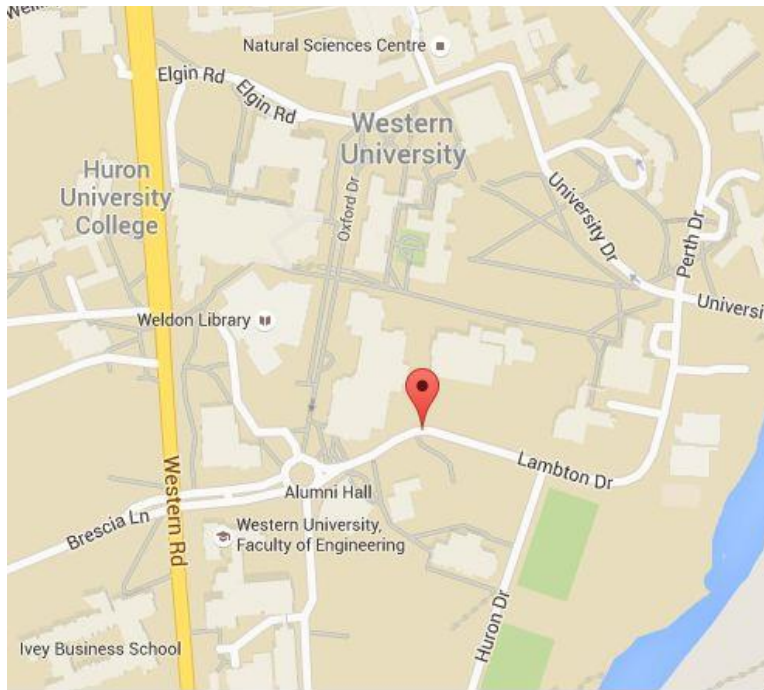
"...any player who has won at least two rounds in any 3 star Ontario Tennis Association (OTA) tournament or higher or equivalent (USTA, European championship) in the three years prior to the beginning of the school year. Any player who has ever played in the Canadian Junior Nationals or any player that has ever played in any provincial championships shall also be considered an Open player. (A bye, defaulted or retired match in an OTA event does not constitute a win.)"

Any player with **ANY** OTA tournament experience **MUST** provide documentation proving their ranked/unranked status. Documentation includes a hardcopy of the OTA player profile which outlines their tournament experience. If the player is no longer an active OTA member, they should contact the OTA and they will email them a copy of their tournament history.
