PARKING:

Gates will be up. Parking is included.

ENTRY FEES:

The entry fee will be \$12 per individual event and \$15 per relay team. ALL CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO "STRATFORD DISTRICT SECONDARY SCHOOL". All fees for OFSAA West Regional and OFSAA are paid from this amount. Franco will send an email indicating the amount due for each school as in previous years.

****On Day One of WOSSAA (Thursday, May 19, 2022), between 8:00 - 9:00 am, all WOSSAA T&F coaches should bring the following items to the registration tables when they pick up their WOSSAA Team Package:***

- a) **WOSSAA Fee Cheque** (Made payable to "Stratford District Secondary School") *Receipts will be issued at the registration tables
- b) **WOSSAA Eligibility list**

COACHES' MEETING:

There will be a brief coaches' meeting at 9:00 am sharp. This will be in the Visitor's Changeroom. Unfortunately, the Alumni Lounge is being renovated and will be unavailable for us to use.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

You may have volunteered or been assigned to help run events at this meet by your Conference Convenor. Huron-Perth and TVRA responsibilities should be completed with volunteer names one week prior to WOSSAA (Friday, May 13, 2022). **Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the event to pick up your athlete list and any equipment necessary.** We will have some extra tapes measures for officials to use, however, please try your best to bring your own equipment. Lunch will be provided for all the **adults who are officiating only**. This will also be served in the Visitor's Changeroom. WEIGH-INS:

Weigh-ins should be done first thing in the morning, located in the hallway outside the Lounge area. **Weigh-ins will only be available from 9:00 am until 10:00 am each morning.**

MARSHALLING:

Marshalling for all Field Events will take place at the competition site.

The Shot Put, Javelin and High Jump areas are located at the bottom of the hill at the far end of the stadium. Coaches and spectators are expected to stay out of this area and may watch from the grass. Discus is located outside the stadium. Coaches and spectators are asked to stay behind the caged area.

Long and Triple Jumps will take place on separate runways (one inside the track, one on the outside) so that the full approach run can be used by all competitors. Coaches and spectators may watch from the East stands. **No coaches or spectators are allowed in the track area.**

Pole Vault will take place near the West stands. Each team may provide one coach to remain in this area during competition. **No other spectators are allowed in this area.**

Marshalling for all Track Events will take place at the start line of each race. Athletes will be marshaled just 15 minutes prior to their event.

Absolutely no coaches, athletes or spectators will be allowed in the infield during the meet.

Athletes will be allowed to warm-up on the back stretch when not in use.

RESULTS/AWARDS:

The results will be posted on the wall inside the building. Real time results will also be posted by Franco on the RMC

website:

An awards table will be set-up just outside the doors of the glassed area. Athletes may pick-up their awards only once the results have been posted.

PROTESTS:

Any protest must be made in writing and submitted to the WOSSAA Convenor, within 30 minutes of the results being posted. A \$100 deposit must accompany the protest and will be refunded if you win the protest.

ADVANCEMENT TO OFSAA WEST REGION:

The **top 5 finishers** in each event shall advance to OFSAA West Region.

- No portable stereo systems are allowed inside TD Waterhouse Stadium.
- No footballs, Frisbees, soccer balls, etc.
- Throwing implements may only be used in the designated completion areas.
- Athletes are reminded that absolutely no club insignia will be allowed in the competition areas.
- Student-athletes must remain fully clothed in the appropriate attire in the competition area, AND use the designated locker room or change area to change to and from competition attire.
