

WOSSAA Tennis Championships 2022

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Date & Time: Thursday, May 19th (Rain date is Friday, May 20th)

8:00 All courts available for warm-up.
8:00 to 8:30 Registration for **ALL players** at **Stratford Tennis Club**.
8:30 Play begins with Girls Singles matches and some Boys Singles matches at Stratford Tennis Club.
Play also begins with Girls Doubles matches at SERC tennis courts.
8:40 Coaches Meeting at Stratford Tennis Club.

Fee: \$17 per athlete -- make cheque payable to Stratford District Secondary School
\$73 per athlete for OFSAA qualifiers (pay at end of WOSSAA tournament)

Parking: It is free at both locations.

Format: All events will be a double-elimination draw (until the final). All matches will be an 8 game pro-set with no-ad scoring. A 12 point tiebreaker will be used for matches tied 7-7.

Seeding: It is the responsibility of the WOSSAA convenor to create the draw based on the input of the coaches and Conference convenors.

Ranked: Convenors and coaches need to identify any ranked players.

A ranked player is "...any player who has won at least two rounds in any 3 star Ontario Tennis Association (OTA) Tournament or higher or equivalent (USTA, European championship) in the three years prior to the beginning of the school year. Any player who has ever played in the Canadian Junior Nationals or any player that has ever played in any provincial championships shall also be considered an OPEN player. (A bye, defaulted or retired match in an OTA event does not constitute a win.)"

Any player with any OTA experience MUST provide documentation proving their ranked/unranked status. documentation includes a hard copy of the OTA player profile which outlines their tournament experience. If the player is no longer an active OTA member, they should contact the OTA and they will email them a copy of their tournament history.

OFSAA: Two ranked entries and two unranked entries per event are permitted from WOSSAA. OFSAA will be held in Toronto from May 30 to June 1, 2022.*

*** Due to fewer associations participating this year, WOSSAA has been awarded one extra entry for HS Girls Singles and one extra entry for HS Boys Singles.**

Notes

The Stratford Tennis Club has four clay courts and two hard courts. Players will play their matches on the first available court (clay or hard).

The Stratford Tennis Club has facilities (washroom, snack bar and seating). You are walking distance to food options.

The Girls Doubles draw will begin at the SERC tennis courts in Stratford. The SERC site has two hard courts. The first ten matches of this draw will take place at SERC. All subsequent matches will take place at the Stratford Tennis Club.

Court supervisors will arrive at the SERC site by 8am if you wish to drop off your players before registering at the Stratford Tennis Club. Match play will begin at 8:30am.

There are washroom facilities at the SERC site but no seating or food or water options.
