PLAYOFF FORMAT:

4 team, 2 game championship. If you win your first game you play for the WOSSAA championship. If you lose your first game you play for the bronze medal.

Semi-final Matchups: TVRA Central vs. Huron Perth
Additional Entry (TVRA Central) vs. TVRA Southeast

All games are hopefully 8 ends. New this year, a game time limit will be imposed, at the 2 hour : 15 minute mark, the end that is in play is the last end, with a maximum game time of 2 hours : 30 minutes. An extra end will be played if a game is tied.

There will be 5 minutes of practice for each team before each game. Last rock is decided by coin toss. Team that chooses last rock gets first practice.

There will be a 5 minute, 4th end break

Two time outs may be called per team per game, one minute in length. If there is an extra end one time out may be called per team (even if they've used their previous 2 in the first 8 ends)

SCHEDULE:

I know this is an early start, and time is tight, but ice availability is limited and we have a hard deadline to be off the ice for 2:00pm.

7:30am - Team/Coaches Meeting: Rules and etiquette. Please arrive on time so we can start promptly. We will meet upstairs (second floor) of the club, stairway to upstairs is located to the right of the bar

8:00am - Each team is allowed a 5-minute pre-game practice.

8:15am - Semi-finals

11:15am - Pre-game practice
