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Athlete Registration/Bib Numbers:

OFSSA eligibility rules must be adhered to.
All athletes must have competed in their Championship race.
New bib numbers will be provided at WOSSAA.
Bib numbers must be worn on the front of the athlete's jersey and must be clearly visible at all times during the race and through the chute.

Facilities/Parking:

Athletes are encouraged to come dressed to run and PREPARED for the weather.
Port-a-potties will be available near the course. Please tell your athletes that they **SHOULD NOT enter the school.**

Athletes are encouraged to bring their own water and food. There will not be food for purchase on site. The closest restaurants are at least 20 minutes to walk (3-5 minute drive).

Please help us to keep the grounds clean.

Medical personnel will be located near the registration/finishing area, as well as at "Location B" on the map (near the split coming out of the forest).

There is parking for cars in the lots surrounding the arena (north of the high school).
Buses are asked to park at Providence United Reformed Church, just east of the high school, 447 Second St.
