PLAYOFF FORMAT:

4 team, 2 game championship. The winner of the first draw of games will play for the WOSSAA championship. The losers of the first draws of games will play for WOSSAA bronze

Draw 1 - SEMI FINAL MATCH UPS:

TVRA Southeast	VS	TVRA Central
TVRA Central (Additional Entry)	VS	Huron Perth

All games are 8 ends with a time limit of 2:30 hrs (no ends begin after the 2:15 hr mark.) An extra end will be played (not included in the time limit)

There will be 7 minutes of practice time for each team before each game. The last rock is decided by coin toss. The team that wins the toss gets the choice of last rock or rock colour. The team with the last rock will practice first.

There will be a 5 minute, 4th end break

Two time outs can be called per team per game. Each time out is one minute in length. If there is an extra end, one additional time out may be called per team.

8 am - Team and coaches meeting: Rules and etiquette. Please arrive on time so we can start promptly. We will meet upstairs in the lounge after the curlers have changed.

8:15 am - Each team will warm up for 7 minutes - first practice as determined by the coin toss.

8:30 am - Draw 1 - Semi Final games - 2 hrs 30 min, no end started after 2hrs 15 min (10:45 am).

11 am to 12 pm - Lunch

12 pm - Each team will warm up for 7 minutes - first practice as determined by the coin toss.

12:15 pm - Draw 2 - Gold and Bronze Medal Games - 2 hrs 30 min, no end started after 2hrs 15 min (2:30 pm).
