



2026 WOSSAA TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP

MEET INFORMATION

Where: Alumni Stadium, Western University, London

When: Thursday, May 21 - Friday, May 22, 2026

PARKING:

- Gates will be up. Parking is free at WOSSAA, and you do not need to use the HONK app to pay.

ENTRY FEES:

- The entry fee will be \$13 per individual event and \$16 per relay team.
- School amounts will be posted to ONTRACK.COM when all scratches and advancements are confirmed.
- Cheques are to be made to **"BANTING SECONDARY SCHOOL"**.
*Fees for OFSAA West Regionals will be paid for by WOSSAA, and each school will be invoiced individually based on the number of athletes attending OFSAA Regionals.
- Franco will send an email indicating the amount due for each school, as in previous years.

ADVANCEMENT TO OFSAA West Regionals:

- The **top 6 finishers** in each event shall advance to OFSAA West Regionals.
- Inform Franco elapi of any **scratches** and confirm relay names by noon on May 23 so that he can advance the next athletes to Regionals.
- Regional information can be found on the [ONTRACK.COM](https://ontrack.com) website when it becomes available.
- OFSAA Rosters and Forms are to be completed before Regionals and submitted online using the OFSAA HUB.
- Supervision forms are to be submitted at OFSAA Regionals. See your A.D. for information on how to register.

COACH'S PACKAGES:

- Team packages can be picked up at the registration table inside the main gates of the stadium.
- WOSSAA Fee Cheques (**Made payable to "Banting Secondary School"**) should be provided at the time of pickup. Only coaches may pick up team packages. ***Receipts** will be issued at the registration tables.

COACHES MEETING:

- There will be a brief coaches' meeting at 9:00 am for announcements, updates or questions, etc, in the Lounge.

EVENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Each conference will be responsible for certain event responsibilities.
- Please complete it by **Monday, May 18**
- Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the event to pick up your athlete list and any equipment necessary.
- We will have tape measures and clipboards for officials to use; however, please try your best to bring your own.
- Lunch will be provided for all the adults who are officiating only. This will also be served in the Lounge.

WEIGH-INS:

- Weigh-ins should be done at least an hour in advance of the event. Weigh-ins will be located near the javelin runway.
- The weigh-in station will close 1-hour before the last event, each day.

MARSHALLING:

- Marshaling for all Field Events will take place at the competition site.
- Coaches and spectators are expected to stay out of this area and may watch from the grass.
- Marshaling for all Track Events will take place near the start line of each race. Athletes will be marshaled 15 minutes before their event.
- Absolutely no coaches, athletes, or spectators will be allowed in the infield during the meet.
- Athletes will be allowed to warm up on the backstretch when not in use.



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BIBS/UNIFORM:

- Number bibs must be worn at all times on the front of the uniform. Numbers will also serve as a pass for athletes to enter the stadium. ***Athletes are asked to keep their numbers on their person at all times, FOR BOTH DAYS.***
- Athletes must have their numbers to gain access to the field.
- Athletes must compete in their school uniforms. Relay team members must wear identical tops. The OFSAA Uniform policy will be in effect.

RESULTS/AWARDS:

- **Live Results** are available at www.onttrack.com and AthleticLive.
- The awards table will be located by the pavilion.

WOSSAA SPIRITWEAR:

- Positive Identity will be on-site with souvenir sales on Thursday and Friday.
- **Online pre-orders** can be ordered at www.wossaa-wear.com and orders can be picked up at the event trailer on-site.
- Please share this link with your athletes. Orders are open until Monday, May 18 at midnight.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **Spectators** must remain in the stands. Please do not stand at the railing.
- **Note all spectators will be charged \$5 per day or \$8 for the Championship.**
- **Tents** in the stand are not to be lower than halfway up the stands, in order to maximize seating and viewing for fans. There is also plenty of room in the greenspace around the stadium for team tents.
- **First Aid** will be available on-site by the door to the pavilion.
- No portable stereo systems are allowed inside Alumni Stadium.
- No footballs, Frisbees, soccer balls, etc.
- Throwing implements may only be used in the designated completion areas.
- Athletes are reminded that absolutely **no club insignia** will be allowed in the competition areas.
- Student-athletes must remain fully clothed in the appropriate attire in the competition area, AND use the designated washroom or change area to change to and from competition attire.
- **FOOD:** The concession stand will be open and available for food and beverages. Subway and Barakat Restaurants are available at the top of the hill along Western Road.
- **GARBAGE:** Please encourage the use of trash containers for depositing garbage. As the meet comes to an end, please ensure that your team area is clean and tidy.
- **EMERGENCY:** In case of a weather emergency, all athletes and coaches will be evacuated to the gymnasium in the Western Athletic Centre, across the street. Coaches are asked to sit with their team, and the meet will resume 30 minutes after the last sighting of lightning.
